


Chapter summaries of To Kill a Mockingbird

Objectives	Students will review the novel by summarizing and listing chapter summary.
Materials	Copies of "To Kill a Mockingbird" by Harper Lee, computers, notebook paper, pencil or pen
Instructions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students should label chapter summaries into what chapter it is about • Chapter summary should be in order • Every chapter should be included • Chapter summary should not exceed more than one sentence • List should be clear and neat • Spelling and grammar should be right
Procedure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Before starting the activity, students should have already read the book. 2. Discuss about each chapters of novel 3. Summarize each chapter into one sentence on your notebook paper 4. Start your computer 5. Go to www.blablalist.com 6. Each student should sign up and create an account for Bla Bla list. 7. Set up a privacy setting 8. Create a list following teacher's instruction 9. Type out your list of chapter summary from your notebook paper 10. Print it out 11. Turn in the hard copy 
Assessment	Grading of list will be based on adherence to the instructions provided.
