Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Following the activity, students will be able to understand the role of the food chain in the animal kingdom.
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Materials will include a brief overview of herbivores, carnivores, and vegetation, and how this is all necessary to sustain an ecosystem.➤ The Disney movie, The Lion King.➤ Google Presenter
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. A brief explanation of the food chain and its role in supporting an ecosystem will be given by the teacher.2. The teacher will then play the movie The Lion King in class.3. After the movie, students will use Google Presenter to create a presentation on one animal in the movie and its role in the food chain.
Teaching Standards	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ At Grade 3 students learn about an increasing variety of organisms. They use appropriate tools and identify similarities and differences among them. Students explore how organisms satisfy their needs in typical environments. Students demonstrate that a variety of living things can be sorted into different groups in many ways using various features, such as how they look, where they live, and how they act, to decide which things belong to which group.

Assessment

- Following this lesson and exercise, the students will be able to explain the importance of the food chain in an ecosystem.

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
