

Topic:	Alphabet Animals
Subject:	Science
Grade:	K-2

Overview:	Students will tour the alphabet from A to Z while making associations between letters and animals.
Objectives:	Students will identify the names of animals that begin with each letter of the alphabet and draw pictures to represent these living creatures.
Materials:	Crayons, markers White construction paper/ poster board
Procedure:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Review the alphabet letter by letter with the students. 2. Tell the students they will make a poster board with each letter of the alphabet with an animal drawn next to make the association. 3. They can choose any animal they want as long as the first letter of each object matches with the letter of the alphabet. 4. Teacher and assistants can walk around to help students as they need it to make sure the association is correct. 5. After this project is finished and the poster boards are presented, the children will then be reevaluated through Survey Monkey. 6. Teacher should find or create themselves a survey through Survey Monkey to test the children's knowledge of the association of animals and letters.
Evaluation:	Children will be tested on their knowledge of recognizing animals as well as making the association to the alphabet.
