

## The Gods and Goddesses of Ancient Greece

### Middle School Lesson Plan

Objective:	Students will be able to name the major Grecian gods and describe what they represent in ancient society.
Materials:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-A survey with questions about ancient Greek mythology</li> <li>-Presentation on PowerPoint or a similar program</li> <li>-A worksheet to evaluate the students after the presentation</li> </ul>
Procedure:	<p>v. Have students fill out a survey on <b>SurveyMonkey</b> that is about the major deities in the religion of ancient Greece.</p> <p>v. This is a two day lesson. The survey is taken one day then the actual lesson is for the next day after the teacher reviews the results of the survey.</p> <p>v. The teacher gives a presentation on PowerPoint or a similar program about the Greek deities. The teacher spends less time on ones the survey showed the students already know more about and more time on those that the students have little or no knowledge of.</p> <p>v. The students break into pairs and fill out a worksheet to be graded to evaluate what they learned for the lesson</p>
Evaluation:	A worksheet about Greek deities.
