

## All About Birds

Grade Level: 4-6

Note: This lesson would be easier to complete if students had prior knowledge of computing skills.

\*Overview: Students will work on a computer to research different types of bird species.

Objectives	By involving students in this activity students will be able to take away concepts such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Researching techniques</li><li>- Knowledge of basic computing skills</li><li>- Presenting skills</li><li>- Computers, internet access, books about birds, poster board, markers</li></ul>
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Computers, internet access, books about birds, poster board, markers</li></ul>
Procedures	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Allow students to get into small groups. 5min.</li><li>2. Students will choose one type of bird and research it using Ustream. 25min.</li><li>3. Have the groups make a posterboard displaying information about their specific bird.</li><li>4. Present their board to the class.</li></ol>
