

Animals in Action

Level	Grades K-5
Students	Physical Education Classes
Materials	Plenty of room, computer with Internet access, gymnastics mats
Purpose	To teach children the ways the body works in motion and to better understand why animals in the wild move and act the way they do.
Objective	Students will: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Learn and imitate how animals move2. Understand how animals move in their natural habitat3. Understand why animals move in different ways
Activities	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Have the students look online at Ustream at different animals they choose themselves.2. Have students study the animal's interactions, movements, etc.3. Have the students then reenact the animals they chose.4. The student will then present what they learned about this animal in front of the class.
Evaluation	Doing the activity (5 points) Presentation (15 points)
