

Insect Metamorphosis

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| Level | Grades K-3 |
| Students | Life Sciences Class |
| Materials | Computer with internet access and webcam, Butterfly Larvae, materials to take care of Larvae |
| Purpose | To teach students about the life cycle of certain insects in order to help them better understand the world that they live in by using Ustream. |
| Objectives | Students should be able to: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Name the different phases of the life of a Butterfly, (ie Larvae, caterpillar, cocoon, and butterfly.)2. Identify those same phases of the life cycle by viewing pictures. |
| Activities | <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. First the students should be taught the metamorphosis process.2. Then the teacher should set up a webcam on Larvae that they have at home so that the students can watch on a broadcasting site to see the real life process instead of just pictures in the books.3. Have the students write out what they see with their parents.4. Bring their paper to class to turn in. |
