



THIS IS AN EXAMPLE OF A LESSON PLAN USING JUSTIN.TV THAT COULD BE USED TO TEACH A 12TH GRADE CLASS

SOCIAL STUDIES: AMERICAN CIVIL WAR

Overview	Students will develop knowledge of the American Civil war by working on civil war facts worksheet, and watching videos on Justin.tv that portray certain events that occurred during the civil war.
Objective	<p>Students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn an overview of various factors which contributed to the war. • Be able to name the major generals of the north and south. • Be able to identify the particular states and its allegiance during the Civil war.
Learning environment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Classroom with a large projection screen. • Computer with a high speed internet connection.

Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20 “Civil War Facts” worksheets • Map worksheets of United States • Projector Screen/Computer/High Speed Internet
Procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First, students will be introduced to the Civil war through discussions about its causes such as slavery, sectarianism, etc. • Then, explain the major figures and events that were a major part of the war. • Next, discuss the importance and implications that war has on us now, and back then. • Open Justin.tv and show the students a short video of the Civil War that you the teacher have uploaded prior to the beginning of class. • Invite other Civil War experts into the chat room for your Justin.tv channel, set up a scheduled time prior to class to make sure that the experts understand what is going on in the lesson. • After watching the video students can then chat with the Civil war experts through the Justin.tv chat room.

Application	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will apply their knowledge of the Civil war when discussion of other wars come up, and see if similar factors contribute to all wars.
Evaluation	The students will complete a short quiz about the American Civil war, and they will also be asked to write a 1 page single space paper answering in their own words, what if the South had won the war?
