Prior Knowledge	Students have a general knowledge of geography (i.e. the seven continents).
Objectives	 Students will: Introduce students to Russian Culture Allow students to learn about Russian names Create an appreciation for Russian Culture Open a window for Students to see what the Russian culture is actually like Develop student appreciation toward diversity
