



Brainstorming Using bubbl.us

Subject: Literature

Grades: 6-8

Duration: 1 class period

<p>Overview</p> 	<p>In this activity students will be writing their own short story. These stories should be based off a tale by Edgar Allen Poe. The students will be using bubbl.us for brainstorming and organizing their ideas for their short stories.</p>
<p>Objective</p>	<p>Pursuing this activity will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Introduce them to a different useful application. - Teach them an easier more efficient way of organizing their ideas. - Build their writing skills. - Enhance their knowledge of Edgar Allen Poe's creative writing.

<p>Evaluation</p>	<p>10 pts. for a completed bubble diagram. If they complete an organized bubble diagram it will show that they understand how to use bubbl.us and make a useful bubble diagram.</p>
